RCCHC is one of many organizations across the state of NC that's actively working with the NC Balance of State and North Carolina Coalition to End Homelessness, in an effort to "End Homelessness in NC."

RCCHC's HHA Patient Navigator, Nicole Boone (Regional Lead of the Northeastern Homeless Coalition), recently attended the "Bringing it Home: Ending Homelessness in NC" 2-day conference from May 8th-9th in Raleigh on the campus of NC State University. There, Nicole was able to "gain best practices, share successful strategies, build relationships through networking, and celebrate the positive impact that organizations are making on ending homelessness in our state." Effectively ending homelessness means that it's rare, brief, and non-recurring.

Governor Roy Cooper was the guest speaker during the opening session of the conference and shared that he "cares about the work that we're doing (NC BOS, NCCEH, and other organizations) and has challenged us to "be innovative" in decreasing and preventing homelessness for all individuals, particularly children and veterans.

What is SHIIP?

The Seniors Health Insurance Information Program counsels Medicare beneficiaries and caregivers about Medicare, Medicare supplements, Medicare Advantage, Medicare Part D, and long-term care insurance.

Who is Eligible?

Anyone who has a question about their Medicare coverage is eligible to speak with one of RCCHC's SHIIP counselors. Those new to Medicare or who need information about choosing a plan may especially benefit.

Creswell May Dayz



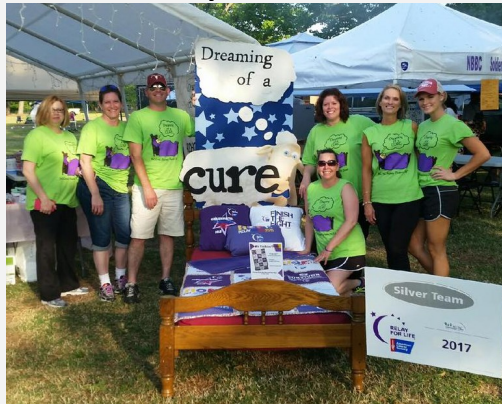
RCCHC's Erielle Cooper had a great time with food, fun and a parade at Creswell May Dayz.
